POSITION SUMMARY

The Foreman serves as the primary field leader and is expected to execute work in accordance with contract documents, project schedules, manufacturer requirements, and Jernigan Drywall's quality standards. The ideal candidate leads by example, communicates clearly, and takes ownership of both workmanship and crew performance.

FIELD SUPERVISION & EXECUTION

- Supervise and coordinate daily field activities for assigned projects
- Direct crews and subcontracted labor to ensure work is performed safely, efficiently, and in accordance with plans and specifications
- Plan daily and weekly work activities to meet schedule and production goals
- Ensure proper installation of drywall, framing, acoustical ceilings, and related interior systems
- Maintain jobsite organization, cleanliness, and professionalism

PLANNING & COORDINATION

- Participate in project kickoff and turnover meetings as required
- Review drawings, specifications, and scopes of work to understand installation requirements
- Coordinate work with Project Managers, other trades, suppliers, and inspectors
- Identify conflicts, constructability issues, or missing information and communicate proactively
- Assist with layout, sequencing, and logistics planning

QUALITY CONTROL

- Enforce Jernigan Drywall quality standards and manufacturer installation requirements
- Perform first-in-place reviews and ongoing inspections of installed work
- Ensure fire-rated, acoustical, and specialty assemblies are installed correctly
- Identify deficiencies early and ensure corrective actions are completed promptly
- Protect completed work from damage by other trades

- Promote and enforce jobsite safety policies and procedures
- Conduct daily safety briefings and ensure crews are working safely
- Ensure compliance with site-specific safety plans and OSHA requirements
- Correct unsafe conditions or behaviors immediately
- Lead by example with a strong safety-first mindset

PRODUCTIVITY & REPORTING

- Track daily manpower, production, and completed work quantities
- Communicate progress, delays, or issues to the Project Manager
- Assist with labor planning and manpower adjustments as needed
- Support accurate reporting of work performed and percent complete

- 5+ years of experience as a drywall foreman or lead mechanic on commercial projects
- Strong knowledge of drywall systems, metal framing, acoustical ceilings, and fire-rated assemblies
